# Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to the last week of Term 3. The week finishes this Friday 28th September. School resumes for students on Tuesday 16th October. I wish everyone a safe and happy Term 3 break.

A school is a place for learning. That is so true for everyone, both children and adults. When we go to church, it also is a time for learning. The readings and the associated homily helps us to learn more about our world and what we need to do. Yesterday's Gospel was from Mark 9: 30-37. This is one of the occasions when Jesus not only acknowledges children but highlights their supreme importance in our lives. What I learnt yesterday was that in ancient times children were precious to their parents, but they had no social or civic status whatsoever. Until a child becomes an adult, they were nobodies. Jesus challenged his apostles to be counter-cultural. "He took a small child, set him in front of them (the apostles), put arms around him and said to them, "Anyone who welcomes one of these little children in my name, welcomes me". Jesus is saying to us all that everyone is important. Everyone needs to be treated equally. Everyone is special in the eyes of our Lord.

Our students here at St Canice's are special and unique. They all contribute to make this school a great place to be. A small and caring Catholic community where we all look to grow in our love and learning.

Over the past few days, there have been a number of occasions where that special light of being a St Canice's student has come shining through. A big thanks to our Stage 2 teachers or all the extra time they have put into this unit of work.


















### **Changes Beginning Term 4**

Wentworth Falls FC is running its annual summer 7aside competition. Anyone can enter a Team. It's lots of fun. No need for coaches.




