Today 10 Japanese students have come to be part of our school for the next week.


Welcome to Kyoka, Nana, Haru, Fuka, Hina, Mina, Koki, Aya, Tai and Miwa.

It is great to have these students at our school and hope they enjoy their time here.




Naplan

5-6 can only read books from the Years 5-6 range.

After you child has read their full quota, and if they read a book from home, let us know as they need to be validated by our librarians.
